# GRACE FAMILY WORSHIP GUIDE *September 6th, 2026*

Sermon Reflections & Activities: Daily questions and activities based on the past week's sermon. Level 1 children can draw, while Level 2 (older children) and Level 3 (teens/adults) discuss the text together.

Worship Song: Prepare for worship by learning one stanza per week, including hand motions for young children.

Memory Verse: A new scripture passage tied to the sermon series every four weeks. Aim to memorize roughly one verse each week.

**Matthew 28:18-20**

<sup>18</sup>**And Jesus came and said to them,  
“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.  
<sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,  
baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son  
and of the Holy Spirit,  
<sup>20</sup>teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.  
And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”**

Weekly Bible Reading: Follow a 3-year chronological plan (5 chapters/week) to build reading habits and align with Sunday School (The Gospel Project) topics.

This Week: **Psalms 83, 84, 85, 86, 87**

# Grace Presbyterian Church September 6<sup>th</sup> – September 12<sup>th</sup>

**Sunday:** Matthew 28:16–17 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. <sup>17</sup> And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted.

- Level 1 — Draw the eleven disciples standing on the mountain. Draw some with doubting faces.
- Level 2 — What two different responses do the disciples have when they see Jesus? What does this tell us about the kinds of people Jesus sends on his mission?
- Level 3 — Do you feel nervous, doubtful, or unprepared to make disciples? How does it encourage you that Jesus used weak and doubting disciples?

**Monday:** Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

- Level 1 — Draw heaven and earth with a crown above them that says “Jesus” on it.
- Level 2 — How much authority does Jesus say has been given to him? Why does that matter before he tells his disciples what to do?
- Level 3 — How should knowing who gave us the great commission change our level of commitment to it? How can you contribute to our mission of “making disciples”?

**Tuesday:** Matthew 28:19a Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,

- Level 1 — Draw a follower of Jesus walking toward someone who does not yet know Jesus.
- Level 2 — Were most people in the nations already disciples of Jesus? What would have to happen for a person who does not know Jesus to become his disciple?
- Level 3 — Think of one person you know who does not yet follow Jesus. What is one way you could begin moving toward that person in love?

**Wednesday:** Matthew 28:19 baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

- Level 1 — Draw someone being baptized, with other Christians gathered around them.
- Level 2 — What part does baptism play in disciple making?
- Level 3 — Why do you think Jesus wants disciples to become part of his visible people rather than simply believing in him by themselves?

**Thursday:** Matthew 28:20a teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.

- Level 1 — Draw one Christian helping another Christian learn something Jesus taught.
- Level 2 & 3 — What is the difference between teaching people to know all that Jesus commanded, and teaching people to “observe” all that Jesus commanded?

**Friday:** Matthew 28:20 And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

- Level 1 — Draw a Christian moving toward another person with the words “I am with you” in a thought bubble.
- Level 2 — What promise does Jesus make after giving his disciples this enormous mission? How long does he promise to be with his church?
- Level 3 — Think again about the person you previously named. What could you actually do in the next 2 weeks to further engage with them?

**Saturday:** Colossians 1:28–29

- Level 1 — Draw a small child growing into a mature adult. Beside it, draw a new Christian growing into a mature follower of Jesus.
- Level 2 & 3 — What questions do you have about this passage?
