Title: Pastor of Young Adults (ordained or pursuing ordination in the PCA)

General Purpose:

To lead and shepherd college students, young adults (approximately 18-35), and their friends and associates in the church and community.

Key Goals and Objectives:

- Provide vision, oversight, and development for young adult ministry.
- Implement relational ministry programs to reach young adults in the church and community.
- Serve the broader church through general pastoral ministry.

Key Job Responsibilities:

I. Personal Development

Be a man who is growing spiritually through the means of grace of the Word, sacraments, and prayer.

II. Program Oversight

- Cast a vision and create an atmosphere that is conducive to building authentic gospel-centered community.
- Build bridges connecting young adults with other generations, helping infuse them into the church body.
- Develop excellent outreach and ministry to college students.
- Shepherd and provide Sunday schools for college students and young adults.
- Provide effective connection points from our local community for young adults to connect and then grow at Grace.
- Develop multiplying followers of Christ who will live for him through singleness, marriage, and parenthood in the church, school, workplace, and community.

III. Recruiting, Developing, and Leading Leaders

- Lead the young adult leadership team.
- Create and implement disciple-making and mentoring strategies so that young adults may benefit from the wisdom and experience of previous generations.
- Recruit, develop, and use the gifts of young leaders to accomplish the vision for young adult ministry.
