## **ZACH ROGERS**

The Senior Pastor Search Committee, united and convinced of God's will, is pleased to nominate Zach Rogers to be called as Grace Presbyterian Church's next Senior Pastor.

Currently, Zach is the Regional Director for Campus Outreach in Central Illinois and a member of Christ Church PCA in Normal, IL.

Married to Sheffey for almost 14 years, they have two children, Riz and Raleigh.

Zach has a Bachelor's degree in Secondary Math Education from Tennessee Tech University and a Masters in Theological Studies from Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis, MO.

### Zach's Testimony

"I grew up in the South where I was surrounded by Christianity, but it wasn't until I was 17 that I came to know Christ. It was the result of a friend's invitation that I attended a Bible study that exposed me to God's Word. and my life was changed forever. God transformed my life and set me on a path to knowing Him and sharing Him with others. Later, I attended Tennessee Tech University where I became involved in Campus Outreach. The rest is history. Excited to share the gospel at campuses where there was limited evangelistic influence. I moved to Illinois to join the Campus Outreach staff. and start ministries on local campuses."

### Zach's Heart

Zach's heart is broken for lost people, particularly in Central Illinois. He loves the Campus Outreach team and mission, but has felt called to Pastoral ministry.

To that end, he began pursuing a seminary education, particularly focusing on the theology of the Bible and original languages to supplement his rich practical experience of leading ministry. As Regional Director at Campus Outreach, he spends most of his time equipping the team in the Great Commission of making disciples of all nations.

His heart is for his family as well. His passion to be a good spiritual leader, husband, and father is evident. He and Sheffey, who is an evangelist in her own right, have a deep relationship and a lively family. Sheffey is very supportive and, together, they are one in the mission.



### Zach & Sheffey's Journey

Meeting at Tennessee Tech, Sheffey was involved in Campus Outreach as well. They were married in December 2008 and moved to Illinois in 2011 to help start the ministry at Eastern Illinois University.

In 2015, Zach became an Area Director overseeing Campus Outreach at Eastern Illinois University and Olivet Nazarene University. In 2017, they moved to Bloomington, IL to establish Campus Outreach at ISU while continuing to oversee Eastern Illinois University. In 2020, Zach was appointed as the Regional Director for Campus Outreach in Central Illinois. In this role, he is accountable to a Board of Grace elders for five campuses, 25+ staff and volunteers, and a budget of more than \$1 million.



### **FAQ's**

#### When will Zach start?

We are still working out the details; but anticipate that Zach will begin in early March with his first official sermon on Palm Sunday. We will likely have an Installation Service in late April.

#### Does he have any experience working with our church staff?

In his role as regional director of Campus Outreach Central Illinois, one of Zach's priorities is to partner with Grace "for its success and God's glory" (COCI website). He has been working closely with several Grace pastors to foster collaboration between Campus Outreach and Grace. He attends Grace's staff meetings and is, in many ways, already part of Grace's team and mission.

#### Where will Zach & Sheffey live?

Once called and approved by the Presbytery, Zach & Sheffey will move to Peoria.

#### How did the Committee find our new pastor?

Throughout the last 18 months, the Committee has been evaluating pastors, matching their capabilities and experiences to Grace's vision as well as their heart to minister to Central Illinois. Zach, who was mentioned to the Committee by several in the congregation, is a great fit.

The Committee is united and excited to see the unfolding of God's plan.





#### What does a Senior Pastor do?

The Senior Pastor shepherds God's flock of believers at Grace. Specifically, that includes: • Serving as primary preacher of the Word and overseer of worship • Leading setting vision for and executing GPC ministries • Providing pastoral leadership for staff, officers, and congregation

- Leading and managing GPC staff
- Inspiring and empowering global and local community outreach


